The only exception will be for works presented at conferences or symposiums, provided that they have been included in the proceedings of such events.

Nevertheless, in the aforementioned case, the work submitted to the journal must always be an improved version, and as distinct as possible from the version included in the proceedings. This should be indicated at the time of submission to the journal, specifying the details of the conferences or symposiums where it was presented, and attaching the version published in the proceedings. It will be the prerogative of the Editorial Committee to decide whether to publish such work, and their decision is final.

The authors signing the work must be the same individuals who contributed to its conception, execution, and development, as well as the acquisition of data, interpretation of results, and the writing and revision of the manuscript.

The lead or corresponding author of the proposed article is required to complete the form below. At the end of this form, the names of all authors of the study (if there is more than one) are listed, along with their respective ORCID codes.

This form must be duly completed and submitted alongside the article proposed for publication. Before submitting a work for publication, it is advisable to consult the checklist for preparing submissions.
